(The audience is asked to take their seats as the show is about to begin...)

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COUNTRY

Good evening, I'm Sonny and I'm from North Beach Primary School.

We respectfully acknowledge the past and present custodians of the land on which we are meeting, the Whadjuk Noongar people. We also acknowledge the contributions of Aboriginal Australians and non- Aboriginal Australians to the education of all children and people in this country.

Please stand for the National Anthem led by Joyleen from Aubin Grove and Evie from Alkimos Beach.

Welcome to ONE BIG VOICE

1: Ladies and gentlemen, boys and girls, welcome to One Big Voice! *I'm Samuel, and I'm from Sacred Heart, Mundaring Primary School. (Pause for applause).*

2: Can you believe there are over 8,000 kids from all across Western Australia performing here at the RAC Arena today? That makes One Big Voice the biggest children's choir in Australia! I'm Sienna, and I'm from Ardross Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

3: There are two amazing shows, one in the afternoon and one in the evening, with different students performing at each one. I'm Gracelyn, and I'm from Ardross Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

4: We will be singing a variety of songs for you, many of them written especially for One Big Voice, and filled with positive messages that encourage us to be our best selves. I'm Bridget, and I'm from Sacred Heart, Mundaring Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

1: Through our songs we've explored kindness, courage, resilience, belonging and friendship, and today we're excited to share this journey with you.

2: At One Big Voice, it's message first

3: Music second

1+2+3+4: Connection always!

ONE BIG VOICE

1: Hi, I'm Boe, and I'm from Rossmoyne Primary School.
(*Pause for applause*).

2: Hi, I'm Genevieve.

3: And I'm Kalea, and we're from Hillarys Primary School.
(*Pause for applause*).

2: Today, thousands of students from schools all across Western Australia have come together for one special purpose – to share music, messages and connection.

3: We may come from different schools, suburbs and communities, but today we stand together as one choir.

1: This song was written especially for One Big Voice by Donna Marwick-O'Brien, and it celebrates everything this festival is about.

2: Believing in ourselves, supporting each other and discovering what can happen when thousands of voices join together.

3: Because one voice can make a difference...

1: But thousands of voices can inspire an arena.

1+2+3: Don't you know what One Big Voice can do?

COMPÈRE ANNOUNCEMENT

1: Hi, I'm Lucy.

2: And I'm Ayla, and we're from Whitfords Catholic Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

1: This is our 25th year of One Big Voice concerts and guess what?... 99% of the show is run by *us*, the kids! Every year, we get to share our thoughts about what should be said before each song.

2: It makes sense since we're the ones learning and singing the songs. So, if the comperes' words sound like yours...

1 & 2: They probably are!

EVERYDAY HEROES

1: Hi, I'm Arjaan, and I'm from Carey Baptist Primary School.
(*Pause for applause*).

2: Hi, I'm Nuala, and I'm from Davallia Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

3: Hi, I'm Lacey, and I'm from Hillcrest Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

1: When I think of heroes, I think of people with superpowers... or people who are famous. But this song, Everyday Heroes, written by Brendan O'Brien and Donna Marwick-O'Brien, reminds us that heroes are all around us, often doing quiet, important things every single day.

2: Yep. They might be someone we walk past every day... someone who helps without being asked... or someone who shows kindness when it's needed most. They don't do it for attention or recognition—but they're always there when it matters.

3: (looking at the audience and the children on the floor) So as you look around this arena... up there in the seats... (pause and point) and down here on the floor... (pause and point) I wonder how many everyday heroes are here right now.

1: I think there might be thousands.

2: Maybe we can ask ourselves...

1+2+3: Could I be someone's everyday hero too?

SAY WHAT YOU MEAN

1: Our next song, *Say What You Mean*, features lyrics by Kiki McCormack and music by Rose Parker, who's here tonight. Hi Rose! (look up, wave, pause for applause). It's about being honest, brave and true to yourself... Hi, I'm Piper, and I'm from Alkimos Beach Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: And I'm Jeorgia, from Success Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: When we say what we mean and mean what we say, we build trust, show respect and make a positive difference.

1: I think the lyrics of the song are a powerful reminder that our words matter.

2: I agree ...but I think our actions matter even more. What we do shows people who we really are.

1: Tonight, we want everyone to be a part of this moment. So, parents and families, get your phones ready.

2: We'll let you know when to sing along and when to light up the room with your phone.

CAN YOU HEAR THE RAIN

1: Hi, I'm Amy, and I'm from Holy Spirit Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: Hi, I'm Eve, and I'm from Karrinyup Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

3: Hi, I'm Jhett.

4: And I'm Evie, and we're from Secret Harbour Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

1: At One Big Voice, we celebrate the many stories, cultures and communities that come together through music.

2: Our next song, Can You Hear the Rain (Boorong Boolah), reminds us of the special connection between people, the land and the seasons.

3: The words "Boorong Boolah" come from the Noongar language and refer to rain, which is a source of life, renewal and hope.

4: Tonight, thousands of voices come together as one, just like the many drops of rain that join to create something powerful. As we sing, we celebrate the connections that unite us across schools, communities and generations.

1+2+3+4: Shhhhh, listen carefully.....Can you hear the rain?

LITTLE TIGER

1: Putting up your hand for a solo or compere role can be scary!

1 + 2: Trust us, we know!

1: Hi, I'm Niamh.

2: And I'm Macy, and we're from West Balcatta Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: Every person on this stage tonight decided to have a go.

1: And that's what our next song, *Little Tiger*, is all about.

2: It's for anyone who has ever felt nervous or unsure... or wondered if they were brave enough.

1: Because courage doesn't mean you're never scared.

2: It means taking that first step anyway.

1 + 2: Roar, little tigers, roar!

I MADE IT

1: Hi, I'm Chloe

2: And I'm Lexi, and we're from Lake Joondalup Baptist College. *(Pause for applause)*.

1: Have you ever had a big dream or wanted to achieve something that felt just a little bit out of reach?

2: Maybe it was learning something new, trying out for a team, performing on a stage, or doing something that felt a little scary.

1: Sometimes we doubt ourselves. We make mistakes, lose confidence, or wonder if we'll ever get there.

2: But every challenge teaches us something. Every setback helps us grow. And every small step brings us closer to our goal.

1: Along the way, there are people who encourage us to keep going - our families, teachers and friends.

2: Many of them are sitting right here in the audience tonight, cheering us on.

1: This song reminds us that success isn't about being perfect.

2: It's about having the courage to keep trying until one day you can proudly say...

1+2: "I made it!"

HERE COMES THE SUN

1: Hi, I'm Javon, and I'm from Riverton Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

2: Hi, I'm William, and I'm homeschooled. *(Pause for applause).*

1: Brrr! Raise your hand if you are tired of the cold, rainy weather and are ready for some warm sunshine?

2: Well, you are in luck! Our next song is a classic feel-good anthem called 'Here Comes the Sun'. It's all about how bright, happy days are just around the corner.

1: To help us bring the sunshine into this room, we want you to smile as brightly as you can on the count of three.

1 & 2: One...two...three...smile!

2: Awesome! Now keep on smiling while we sing...

1+2: Here comes the sun!

GO WITH THE FLOW

1: Hi, I'm Ollie and I'm from Calista Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

2: Hi, I'm Chenaya.

3: And I'm Johnathan, and we're from Providence Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

3: Sometimes I drive myself nuts trying so hard to get everything right... and yet it still doesn't always work out! While we were learning our next song in choir, Go With the Flow by Donna Marwick-O'Brien, I started to realise I don't always need all the answers, all the time – sometimes it's okay to just let things go.

2: That happened with me too... it got me thinking about making mistakes, because let's face it, no matter who we are, we all make them. And sometimes those mistakes lead to something unexpected... and we start to think, *hey, I wonder what I could create?*

1: Although this song is about going with the flow and not getting caught up in the little things, it's also a huge reminder that when something really matters, we need to stand strong and say...

1+2+3: NO! (hand in stop motion)

INTRODUCING DIRECTORS

1: Hi, I'm Isla from Woodlands Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: And I'm Cora from Burns Beach Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

1: One Big Voice involves many people and parts.

2: That's right. Our teachers prepare us... And the committee works behind the scenes all year. They believe in the power of music and want us to sing positive, uplifting and life-affirming songs.

1: Please welcome two key members of the One Big Voice team to say a few words. Our Creative Director, Donna Marwick-O'Brien and our Regional Director, Kiki McCormack.

UNTAMED

1: Hi, I'm Shona from Duncraig Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: I'm Harry.

3: And I'm Piper, and we're from Glengarry Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: Have you ever felt like there's something bigger inside you... just waiting to come out? Like a part of you that's ready to be seen and heard?

3: Yes! I think that deep down, we all have something powerful. Like our voice, our courage, our choice!

1: A big shout out to Nat Ripepi for writing this song. It reminds us that we don't have to stay small. We don't have to stay inside that cage.

2: That's right. We can step out... and into our light. Even if it feels a little scary at first.

3: It might even feel like we're walking straight into the fire. But maybe that's where we find our strength.

1: Maybe we were never meant to stay quiet. Maybe we were always meant to be more.

1+2+3: We are the wolves, and tonight *WE'RE GONNA HOWL!*

1: Hi, I'm Maci.

2: And I'm Anika, and we're from Bicton Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

1: Ladies and gentlemen, boys and girls, it's what we've all been waiting for...

1+2: Karaoke Time!

1: Are you ready to sing? Well then, we have a song coming up that we are pretty sure most of you already know... and we are going to need your help!

2: That's right, for the next few minutes you're not just a part of the audience. You. Are. A. Part. Of...

1+2: Let’s hear you one more time!

(1+2 lead audience in practice).

1+2: Fantastic!

1: Are you ready?

2: Let’s go!

1: Hi, I'm Aubrey.

2: And I'm Eliya, and we're from Aubin Grove Primary School. *(Pause for applause)*.

1: Have you ever had one of those days where everything just seems to go right?

2: A day when you're surrounded by friends, having fun and making great memories?

1: A day you know you'll still be talking about years from now?

2: That's exactly what this next song is about. It's about appreciating the good moments and enjoying the people you're sharing them with.

1: And looking around this arena tonight, we're pretty sure there are a lot of people creating special memories right now.

2: So, let's enjoy this moment, share the joy with the people around us, and celebrate what might just be...

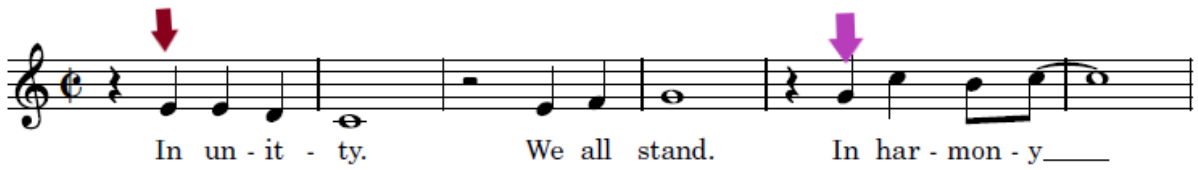

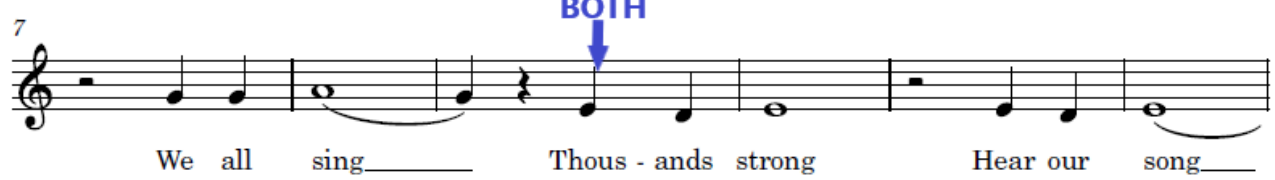

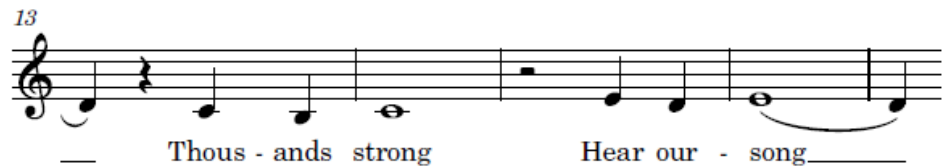
