ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COUNTRY

Good afternoon, I'm Paneshe and I'm from Salvado Primary School.

We respectfully acknowledge the past and present custodians of the land on which we are meeting, the Whadjuk Noongar people. We also acknowledge the contributions of Aboriginal Australians and non- Aboriginal Australians to the education of all children and people in this country.

Please stand for the National Anthem led by Shrey from Hammond Park Primary School.

Welcome to ONE BIG VOICE

1: Ladies and gentlemen, boys and girls, welcome to One Big Voice! *I'm Isabella and I'm from Kinross Primary School. (Pause for applause).*

2: Can you believe there are over 8,000 kids from all across Western Australia performing here at the RAC Arena today? That makes One Big Voice the biggest children's choir in Australia! I'm Lenny from North Parmelia Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

3: There are two amazing shows, one in the afternoon and one in the evening, with different students performing at each one. I'm Dot and I'm from Kinross Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

4: We will be singing a variety of songs for you, many of them written especially for One Big Voice and filled with positive messages that encourage us to be our best selves. I'm Jeremy and I'm from North Parmelia Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

1: Through our songs we've explored kindness , courage, resilience, belonging and friendship, and today we're excited to share this journey with you.

2: At One Big Voice, it's message first

3: Music second

ONE BIG VOICE

1: Hi, I'm Archie and I'm from Neerigan Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

2: Hi, I'm Scarlett and I'm from Hillarys Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

1: Today, thousands of students from schools all across Western Australia have come together for one special purpose, to share music, messages and connection.

2: We may come from different schools, suburbs and communities, but today we stand together as one choir.

1: This song was written especially for One Big Voice by Donna Marwick-O'Brien, and it celebrates everything this festival is about.

2: Believing in ourselves, supporting each other and discovering what can happen when thousands of voices join together.

1: Because one voice can make a difference...

2: But thousands of voices can inspire an arena.

Both: Don't you know what One Big Voice can do?

COMPÈRE ANNOUNCEMENT

1: Hi, I'm Ella and I'm from St Anthony's Greenwood Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: Hi, I'm Avri and I'm from Falls Road Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

1: This is our 25th year of One Big Voice concerts and guess what?... 99% of the show is run by *us*, the kids! Every year, we get to share our thoughts about what should be said before each song.

2: It makes sense since we're the ones learning and singing the songs. So, if the comperes' words sound like yours...

1 & 2: They probably are!

EVERYDAY HEROES – MATINEE

1: Hi, I'm Angelina and I'm from Harmony Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

2: Hi, I'm Bree and I'm from Toodyay Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

3: And, I'm Alara and I'm from Clarkson Primary School. *(Pause for applause).*

1: When I think of heroes, I think of people with superpowers... or people who are famous.

2: Well, growing up in Toodyay, in the Wheatbelt region, heroes can look very different. They are the volunteers who respond when the fire siren goes. They're the people who quietly help their neighbours, the teachers, workers, SES crews, and community members who are always there when it matters most. Out here, people don't help for attention, they just do it because that's what communities do.

3: *(Looking at the audience and the children on the floor)*
As you look around this arena... up there in the seats...
(pause and point) and down here on the floor... *(pause and point)* I wonder how many everyday heroes are here right now.

1: I think there might be thousands.

2: A lot of them don't even realise they are heroes.

3: Maybe, while we're singing this song, we can ask ourselves... could I be someone's everyday hero too?

SAY WHAT YOU MEAN

1: Our next song, *Say What You Mean*, features lyrics by Kiki McCormack and music by Rose Parker, who's here tonight. Hi Rose! (look up, wave, pause for applause). It's about being honest, brave and true to yourself... Hi, I'm Emily.

2: And I'm Lily-Anna and we're from Padbury Primary School. (*Pause for applause*).

2: When we say what we mean and mean what we say, we build trust, show respect and make a positive difference.

1: I think the lyrics of the song are a powerful reminder that our words matter.

2: I agree ...but I think our actions matter even more. What we do, shows people who we really are.

1: Today, we want everyone to be a part of this moment. So, parents and families, get your phones ready.

2: We'll let you know when to sing along and when to light up the room with your phone.

CAN YOU HEAR THE RAIN

1: Hi, I'm Aliviah.

2: I'm Willow.

3: And I'm Charlotte.

1+2+3: And we're from Gidgeannup Primary School.

1: At One Big Voice, we celebrate the many stories, cultures and communities that come together through music.

2: Our next song, Can You Hear the Rain (Boorong Boolah), reminds us of the special connection between people, the land and the seasons.

3: The words "Boorong Boolah" come from the Noongar language and refer to rain which is a source of life, renewal and hope.

1: Today, thousands of voices come together as one, just like the many drops of rain that join to create something powerful.

2: As we sing, we celebrate the connections that unite us across schools, communities and generations.

3: Shhhhh, listen carefully.....Can you hear the rain?

LITTLE TIGER

1: Putting up your hand for a solo or compere role can be scary!

1 + 2: Trust us, we know!

1: I'm Nethya and I'm from Embleton Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

2: I'm Emma and I'm from Quintilian Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

2: Every person on this stage today decided to have a go.

1: And that's what our next song, *Little Tiger*, is all about.

2: It's for anyone who has ever felt nervous or unsure... or wondered if they were brave enough.

1: Because courage doesn't mean you're never scared.

2: It means taking that first step anyway.

1 + 2: Roar, little tigers, roar!

I MADE IT

1: Hi, I'm Charli and I'm from Creaney Primary School. *(Pause for applause)*.

2: And, I'm Zoe from Gwynne Park Primary School. *(Pause for applause)*.

1: Have you ever had a big dream or wanted to achieve something that felt just a little bit out of reach?

2: Maybe it was learning something new, trying out for a team, performing on a stage, or doing something that felt a little scary.

1: Sometimes we doubt ourselves. We make mistakes, lose confidence, or wonder if we'll ever get there.

2: But every challenge teaches us something. Every setback helps us grow. And every small step brings us closer to our goal.

1: Along the way, there are people who encourage us to keep going - our families, teachers and friends.

2: Many of them are sitting right here in the audience tonight, cheering us on.

1: This song reminds us that success isn't about being perfect.

2: It's about having the courage to keep trying until one day you can proudly say...

1+2: "I made it!"

HERE COMES THE SUN

1: Hi, I'm Alexandra

2: And I'm Joelene and we're from Tranby Primary School. *(Pause for applause)*.

1: Have you noticed how everything feels a little better when the sun comes out?

2: Yes, actually, I have. This song reminds us that even when life feels cloudy, brighter days are ahead.

1: The good news is that tough days don't last forever. Just like the sun always comes out after the rain...

2: So if you're going through a tough time....

1: Don't give up....

2: Your sunshine might be closer than you think.

1+2: Here comes the sun!

GO WITH THE FLOW

1: Hi, I'm Mia and I'm from Lathlain Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

2: Hi, I'm Luna and I'm from Bambara Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

2: Sometimes I drive myself nuts trying so hard to get everything right... and yet it still doesn't always work out! While we were learning our next song in choir, Go With the Flow by Donna Marwick-O'Brien, I started to realise I don't always need all the answers, all the time, sometimes it's okay to just let things go.

1: That happened with me too... it got me thinking about making mistakes, because let's face it, no matter who we are, we all make them. And sometimes those mistakes lead to something unexpected... and we start to think, *hey, I wonder what I could create?*

2: Although this song is about going with the flow and not getting caught up in the little things, it's also a huge reminder that when something really matters, we need to stand strong and say...

INTRODUCING DIRECTORS

1: Hi, I'm Chloe and I'm from Christ the King Primary School. *(Pause for applause)*.

2: Hi, I'm Mia and I'm from Lathlain Primary School. *(Pause for applause)*.

1: One Big Voice involves many people and parts.

2: That's right. our teachers prepare us... And the committee works behind the scenes all year. They believe in the power of music and want us to sing positive, uplifting and life-affirming songs.

1: Please welcome two key members of the One Big Voice team to say a few words. Our Creative Director, Donna Marwick-O'Brien And our Regional Director, Kiki McCormack.

UNTAMED

1: Hi, I'm Harriet.

2: I'm Nadia.

3: And I'm Indie and we're from Mater Christi Primary School.
(Pause for applause).

1: Have you ever felt like there's something bigger inside you... just waiting to come out? Like a part of you that's ready to be seen and heard?

2: Yes! I think that deep down, we all have something powerful. Like our voice, our courage, our choice!

3: A big shout out to Nat Ripepi for writing this song. It reminds us that we don't have to stay small. We don't have to stay inside that cage.

1: That's right. We can step out... and into our light. Even if it feels a little scary at first.

2: It might even feel like we're walking straight into the fire. But maybe that's where we find our strength.

3: Maybe we were never meant to stay quiet. Maybe we were always meant to be more.

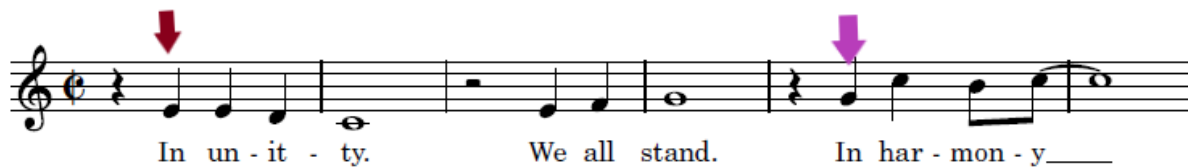

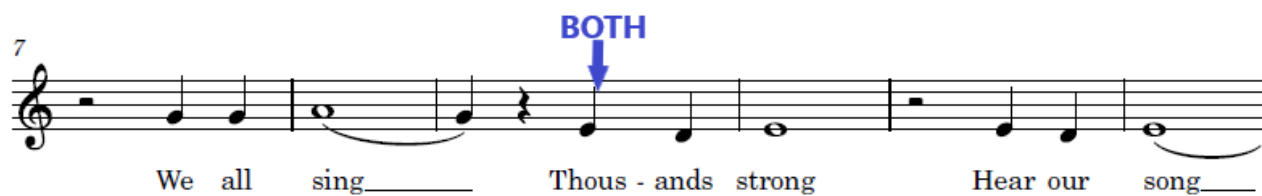

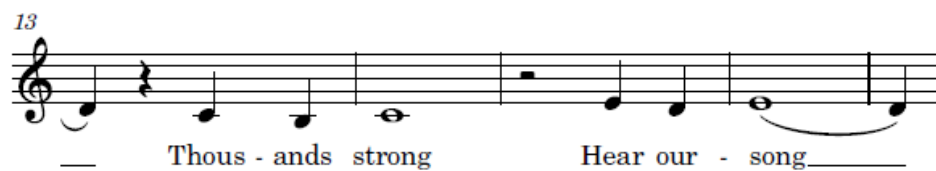
